

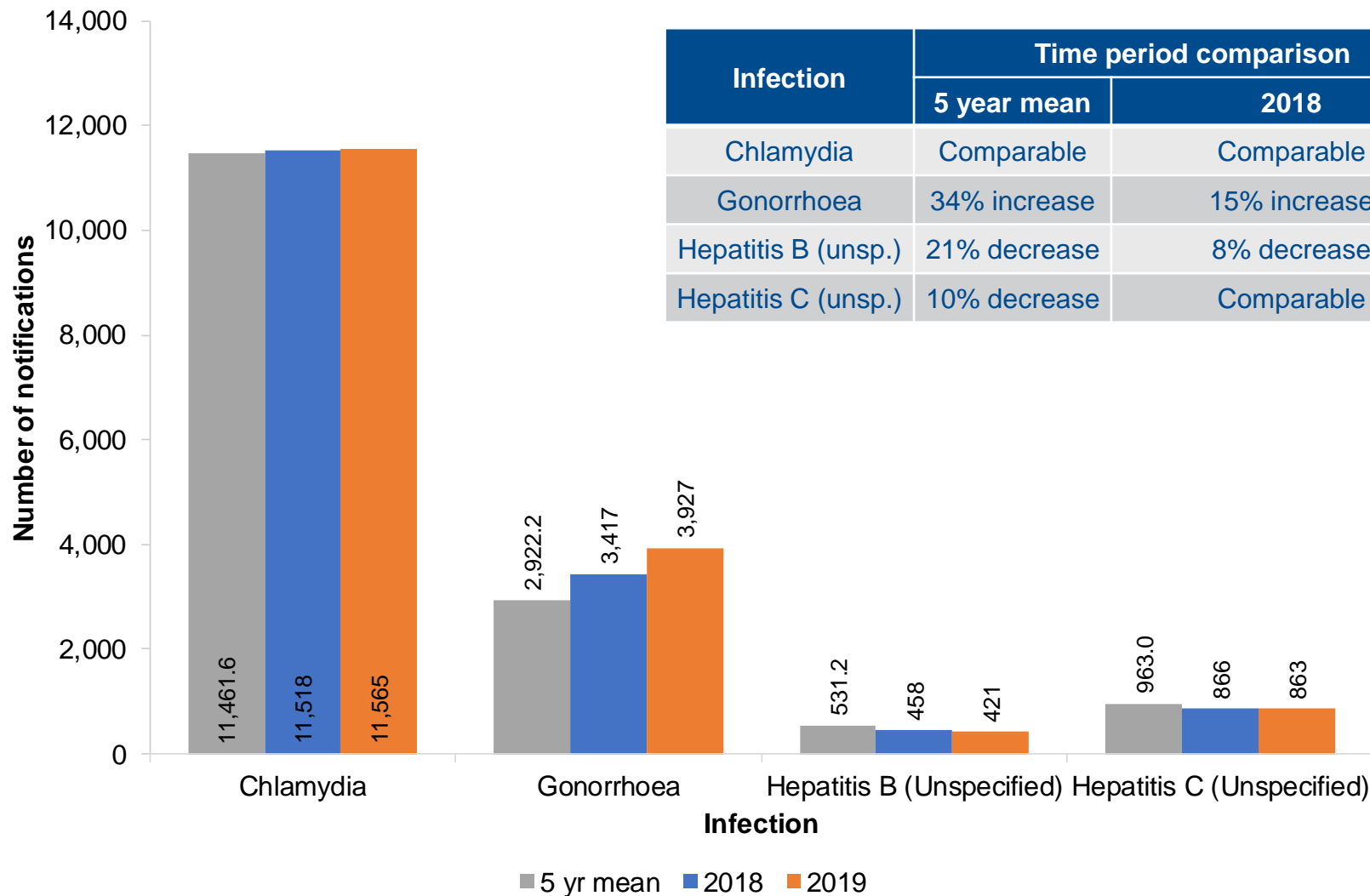

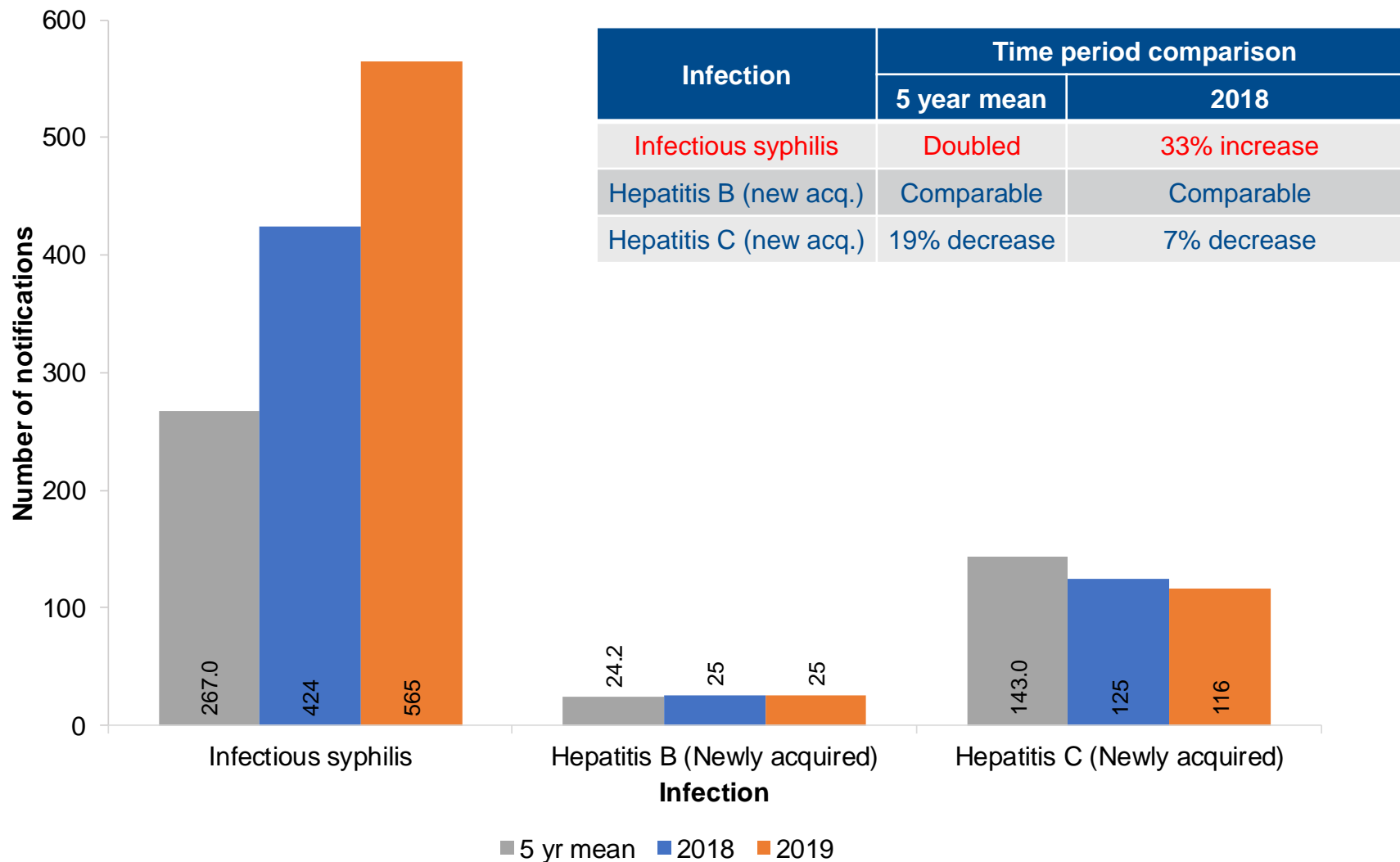

# Number of chlamydia, gonorrhoea, unspecified hepatitis B & unspecified hepatitis C notifications in WA by time period

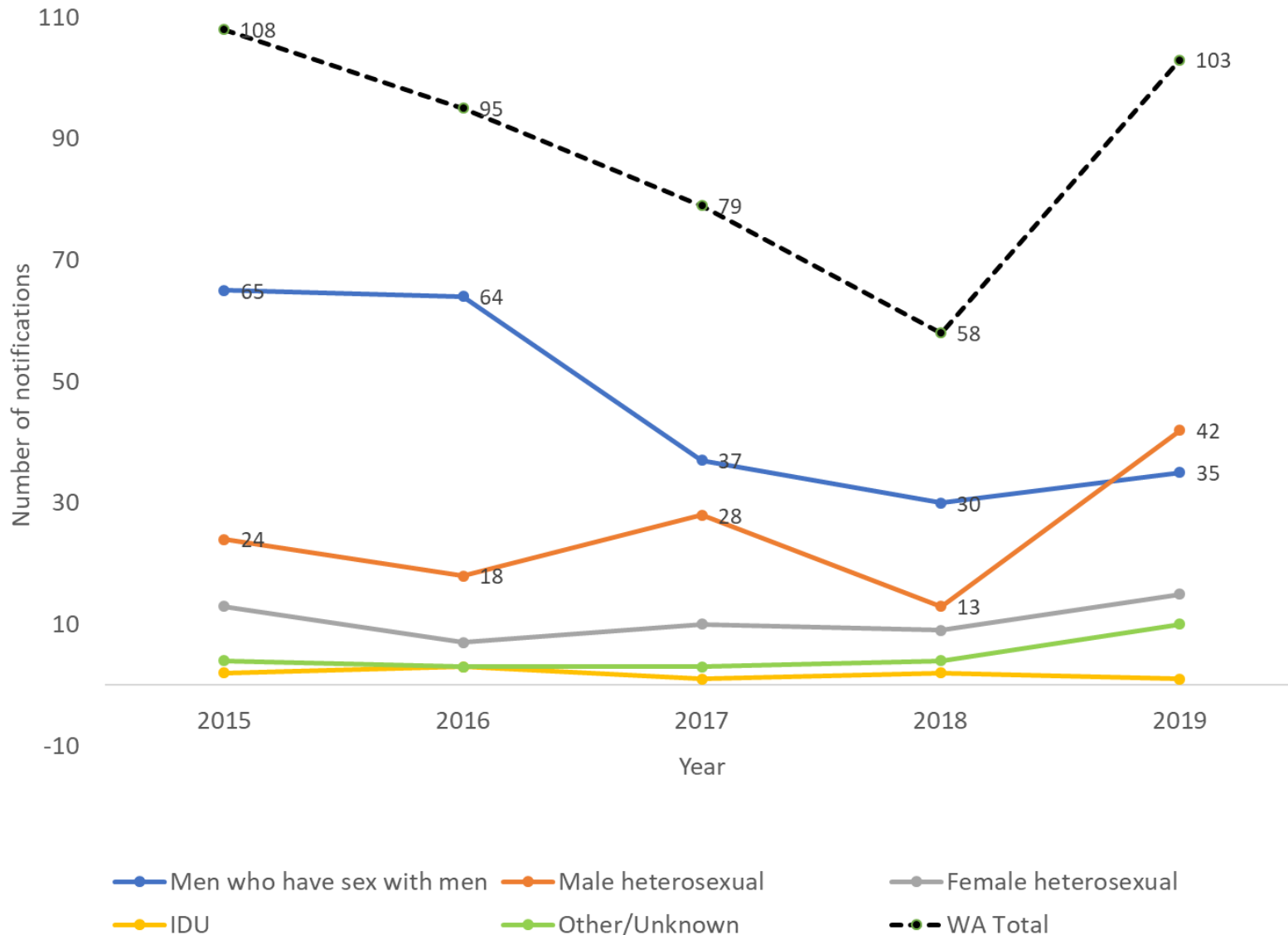


# Number of infectious syphilis, newly acquired hepatitis B & newly acquired hepatitis C notifications in WA by time period

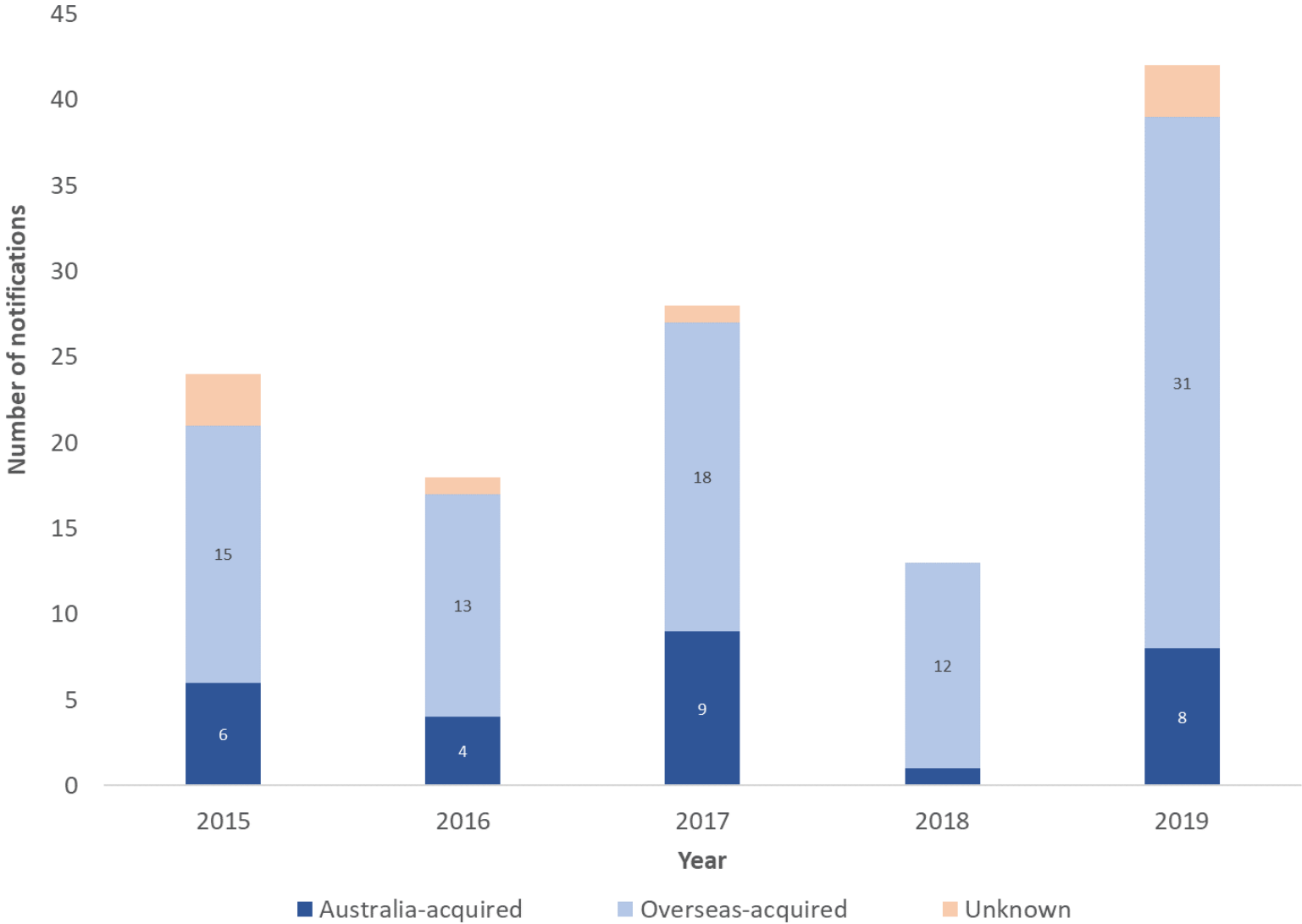

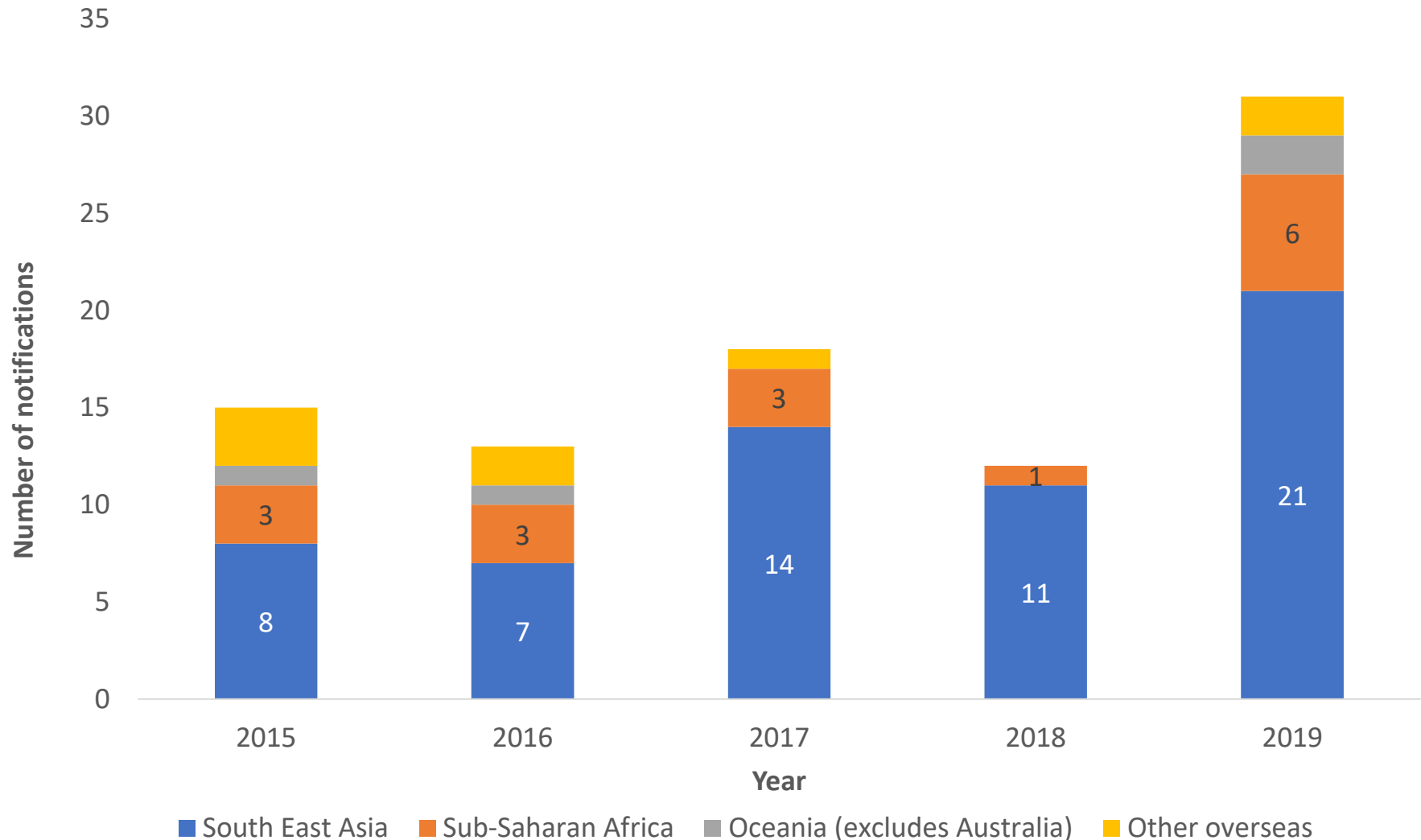
# Number of HIV notifications in WA by exposure category from 2015 to 2019



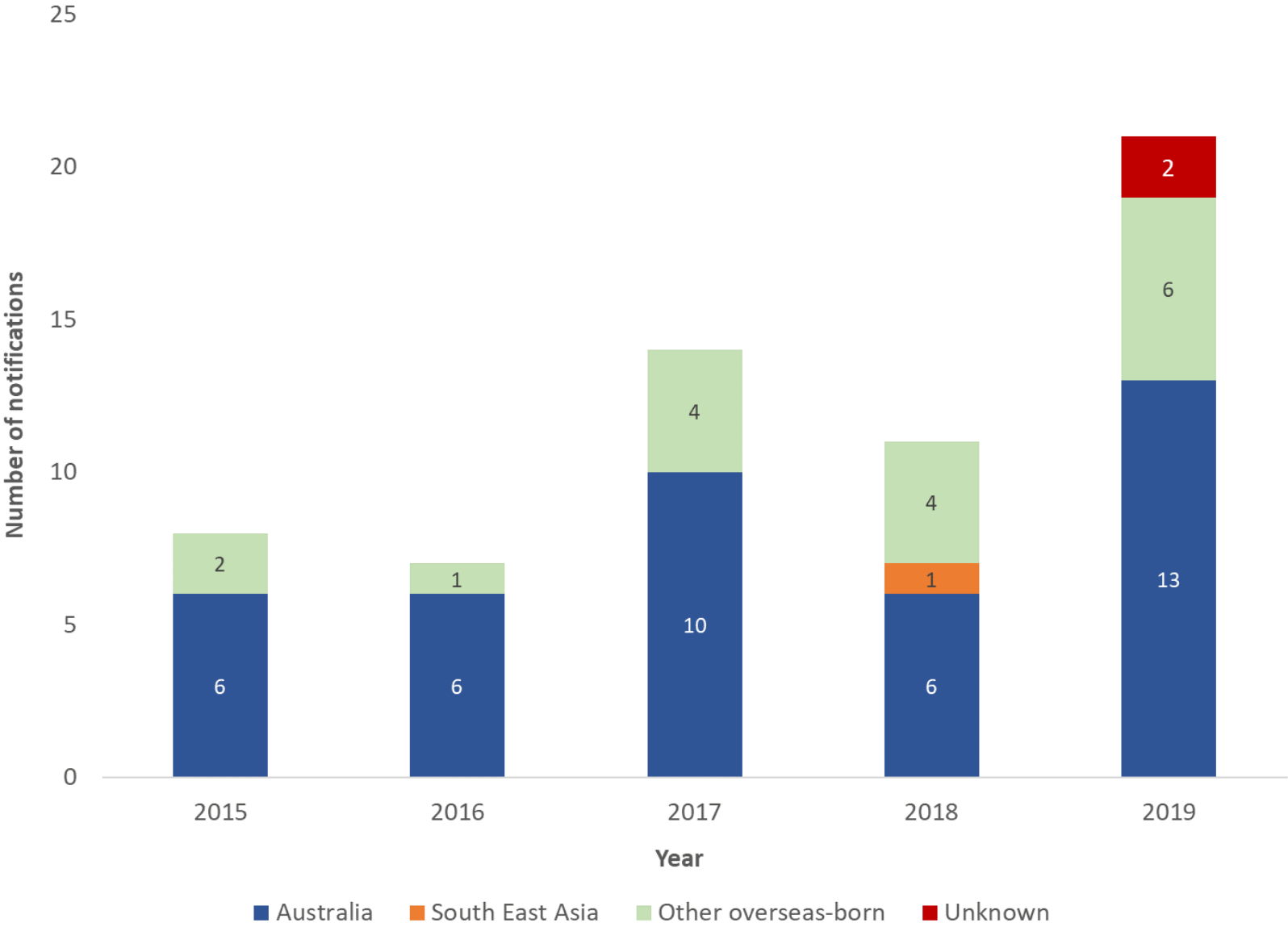
# Number of male heterosexual HIV notifications in WA by place of acquisition from 2015 to 2019



# Male heterosexual HIV notifications, overseas-acquired by region of acquisition, WA residents 2015 to 2019



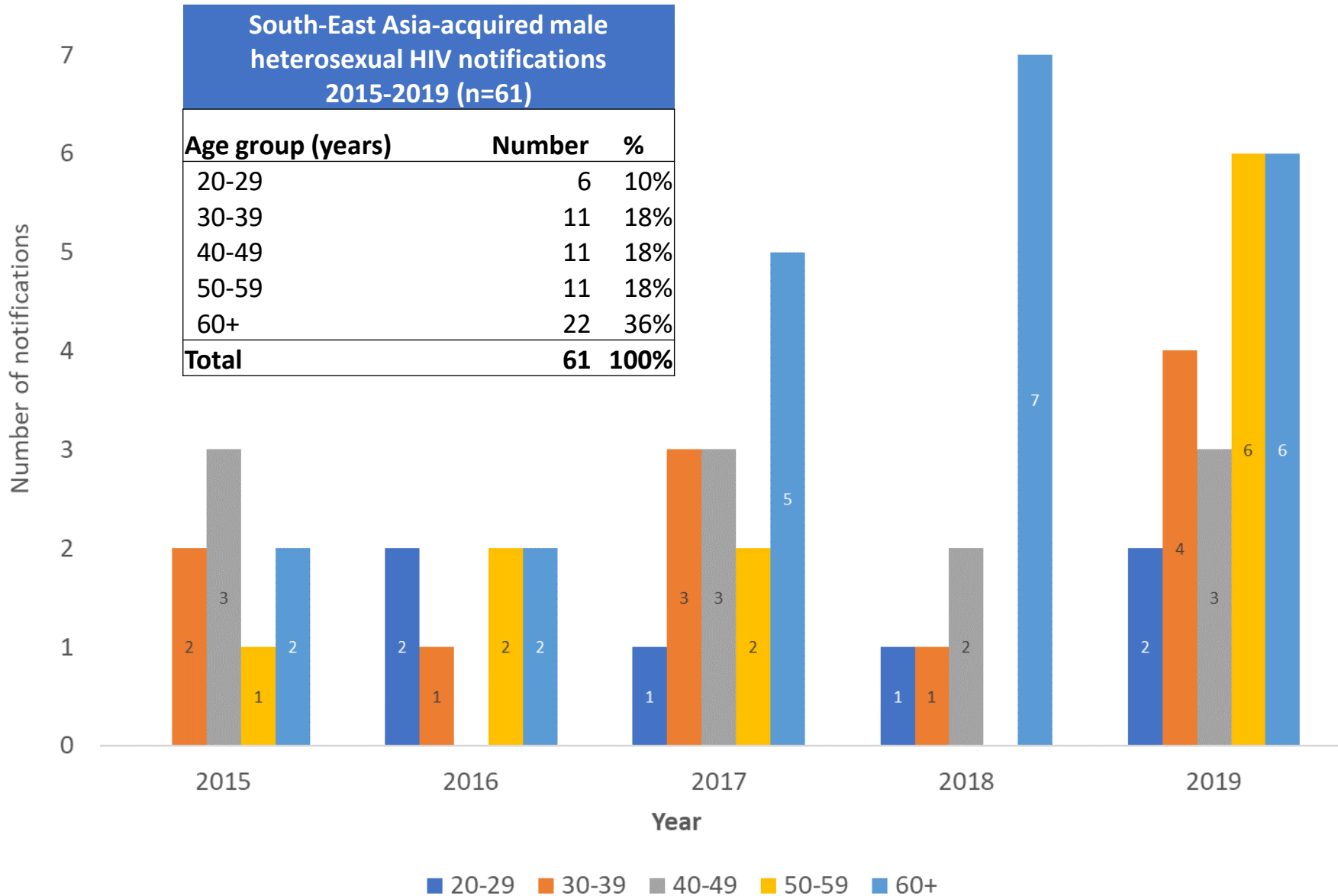
# South-East Asia-acquired male heterosexual HIV notifications by place of birth, WA residents 2015 to 2019

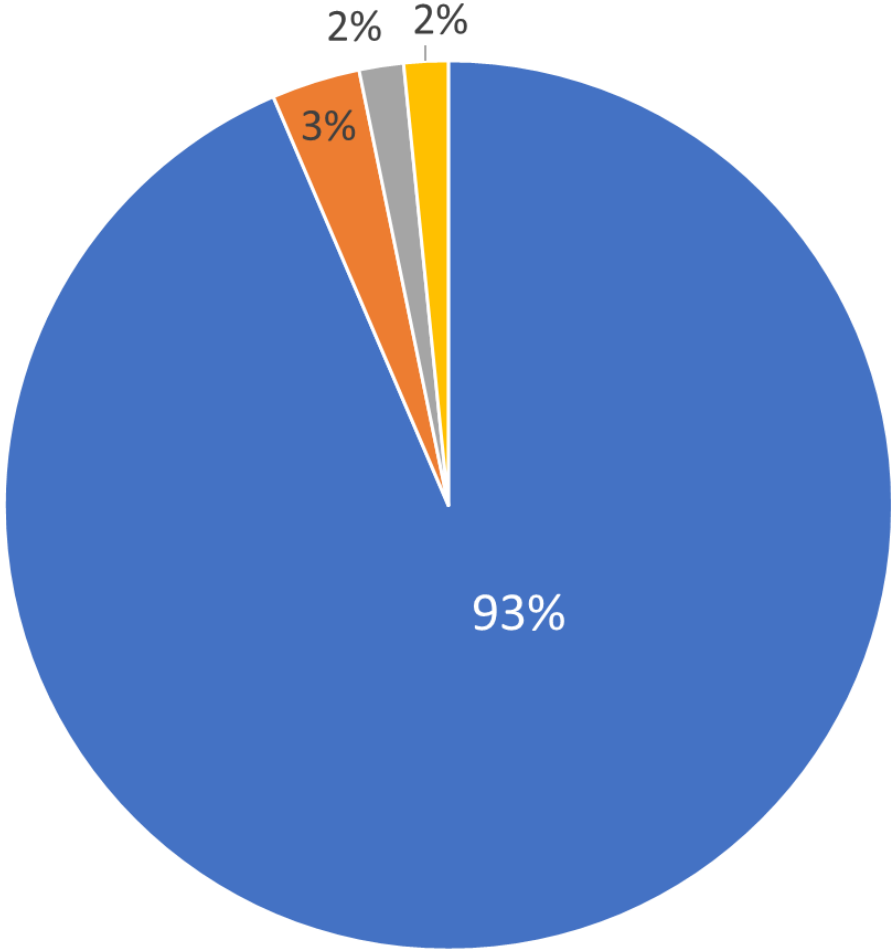
