

Contact details for Western Australian rural and regional falls prevention services available

The WA Country Health Services deliver a range of services and programs specifically developed to meet the needs of older adults at risk of falls. While Falls Clinics and Falls Specialist programs are available in some Regional Areas, older adults in all areas also have access to specialist medical review (if needed) by Resident Geriatricians, TeleGeriatric Clinics (where delivered) or by a Visiting Geriatrician service. These can further advise with regards to falls prevention and liaise with the local medical and allied health team in the region regarding suggested interventions.
