Service profile	Statewide service hosted by the Perth Children's Hospital (paediatric public hospital) providing clinical and consultative services for children with life-limiting conditions. The core team consists of specialist palliative care medical and nursing staff, and social work staff with administrative support. Multidisciplinary care based on the unique needs of the patients, carer and family when facing a life-limiting prognosis including: symptom management addressing emotional and social concerns assisting with clinical decision making and advance care plans assisting primary medical teams with care coordination aiding access to equipment and resources providing quality care for those approaching the end of life aiming to support choice of place of care at end of life transitioning to adult health services bereavement support. Care is provided through shared care between primary care, specialist and community services.
