0711/01 Portal gastropathy

Q.

Please confirm past coding advice for portal gastropathy is still correct?

A.

Past advice (WA decision W0112) is still correct.

Portal gastropathy is congestion of the distal stomach due to increased pooling of blood in the veins that drain the stomach, caused by portal hypertension. Assign K31.88 *Other specified diseases of stomach and duodenum*.

DECISION

Portal gastropathy should be coded K31.88 *Other specified diseases of stomach and duodenum*.
