Q.

How should a Carotid occlusion test be coded?

A.

Documentation from a previous CAP Meeting indicates it was suggested (based on a Victorian Coding Committee decision) to assign:

35321-00 [767] *Transcatheter embolisation of blood vessel* (N.B this code has changed in 6th edition).

DECISION

Carotid Occlusion Test should be coded:

35321-03 [768] *Transcatheter embolisation of blood vessels, head and neck*
