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Overview

Introduction

This report pertains to data records of Home and Community Care (HACC) clients (care recipients and their carers), who received or were receiving one or more HACC services between 1 July 2015 and 30 June 2016. This report includes any revised data submitted for all four quarters of the financial year 2015/16.

HACC Program

The HACC Program is a key provider of basic community care services to frail older people and younger people with disabilities and their carers. The HACC Program aims to maintain or improve the independence of people in these groups and to avoid or delay their premature admission to long term residential care through the provision of basic maintenance and support services.

HACC Minimum Dataset (V2)

The data elements included in the HACC Minimum Data Set (MDS) and defined in the HACC National MDS User Guide Data Dictionary 2.0 are considered to be the minimum information requirements for reporting within the HACC program.

They relate to:

- The characteristics of care recipients (e.g. gender, date of birth, Indigenous status, functional status items)
- The circumstances of care recipients (e.g. where they live, whether they have a carer)
- The characteristics of carers (e.g. date of birth, gender, Indigenous status)
- Information about the service episode (e.g. source of referral, date of entry, date of last update)
- The assistance received by care recipients and carers from the HACC program (e.g. amounts and types of assistance received).



Data Preparation

The HACC MDS is reported to the National Data Repository on a quarterly basis by HACC service providers. All clients receiving HACC services or who ceased receiving services in the quarter will have at least one MDS record. A client may have several MDS records in the period as they may be receiving HACC services from several service providers.

There were 310,881 HACC MDS records in the 2015/16 HACC revised annual data set. Of those, 1,150 records did not have any assistance recorded and were excluded leaving 309,731 records.

A total of 309,731 records were aggregated to care recipient level on the basis of the variable *Statistical Linkage Key* (SLK). The SLK is composed of the 2nd, 3rd and 5th letters of the client's surname, the 2nd and 3rd letters of the first name, the date of birth (in the format DDMMYYY) and the gender (1=male, 2=female or 9=other).

This aggregation resulted in **74,154** records used in the 2015/16 annual report.

The same aggregation rules as in previous years' analyses were applied to determine the value of each variable used in the analysis, as a care recipient may be receiving services by several service providers and may have multiple MDS entries with differing values for the same variable. This process is described below:

- 1) The data were first sorted by ascending SLK and Agency ID.
- 2) Variables which by definition should have the same value if multiple records are present (i.e. Country of Birth, Main Language spoken, Indigenous status, DVA, Pension status)

The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was "missing" or "not stated" the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was "missing" or "not stated" as well as another value then the other value was used.

3) Variables which could have different values in multiple records (e.g. *Postcode, Living arrangements, Accommodation setting* could be different if a care recipient moved; Carer details could be different if a carer stopped caring for a person during the year or if another carer took over; *Referral source, Reason for cessation* could be different in separate records)

The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was "missing" or "not stated" the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was "missing" or "not stated" as well as another value then the other value was used.

4) Carer exists

If this variable had a value of 'Yes' in one MDS record of a care recipient with multiple records in the year, then it was assumed that that care recipient had a carer regardless of other records indicating the opposite.

5) Functional status variables

The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was "missing" or "not stated" the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was "missing" or "not stated" as well as another value then the other value was used.

6) Types of assistance variables

The values of each variable for various types of assistance were summed up to generate a variable composed of the total amount of each type of service received.

Clients were allocated to HACC Planning regions and subregions on the basis of their residential postcode which along with suburb/town is reported in the MDS (in the variable *Locality*).

In determining *Carers* and *Carers receiving HACC services* the following variables were used:

Carer.	Carer Exists = Yes
Carer receiving HACC service:	a value > 0 in variable CSIA_C (Counselling-Carer) and/or a value > 0 in variable RC (Respite Care)

The term **clients** is used throughout this report to refer to care recipients. A care recipient may have a carer and if both received HACC services, their MDS data is included in the same record. A carer may also be classed as a care recipient if the MDS record is reported under their own SLK and the only types of HACC services reported are carer specific services.

The HACC Minimum Data Set (MDS) is reported by HACC service providers and records services provided to both care recipients and their carers. Care recipients may or may not have a carer and only a proportion of carers receive <u>carer specific</u> HACC services, namely *Respite Care* and/or *Counselling, Support, Information and Advocacy*, to support them in their caring role.

The number of care recipients receiving HACC support decreased by **0.8%** in the 2015/16 reporting period (**74,154** vs. 74,773 in 2014/15). The proportion of HACC care recipients who reported having a carer this year was slightly lower compared to last year's report (**25.3%** vs. 25.7% in 2014/15). In actual numbers, it was a decrease of **2.6%** (**18,724** carers down from 19,223 last year). The proportion of carers receiving carer specific HACC services also decreased by **0.7%** (**15.7%** down from 16.4% in last year's report). In actual numbers there were **206** fewer carers receiving HACC services in this year's reporting period (**2,948** carers vs. 3,154 carers in 2014/15).

The number of new clients refers to clients who were not receiving any HACC services in the single previous reporting quarter. This may be within the current financial year or for clients reported in the July to September quarter, in the last quarter of the previous financial year. The 2015/16 reporting period recorded a slight increase (+0.5%) in the number of new clients as compared to 2014/15 (28,870 vs. 28,721 in 2014/15).



During the 2015/16 reporting period, the highest proportion of HACC care recipients were from the 75-89 age group (**52.1%**), followed by those in the 65-74 age group (**18.8%**). These proportions were similar to last year's HACC report where the highest proportion of HACC care recipients was from the 75-89 age group (52.0%), followed by 18.9% in the 65-74 group. The proportion of HACC care recipients younger than 50 years was slightly lower compared to last year's report (**8.3%** vs. 8.6% in 2014/15). Conversely, the proportion of HACC care recipients aged 90 years and above was slightly higher compared to last year (**9.5%** vs. 9.0% in 2014/15).

Figure 1: Proportions of Care Recipients by Age Groups & Region



As shown in Figure 1, the Pilbara and the Kimberley regions have higher proportions of younger care recipients (ages 0-49). This was consistent with data reported in 2014/15.

The proportion of care recipients with a missing date of birth was small at 0.14%.

Figure 2: Proportion of Care Recipients by Age Groups, Indigenous Status & Region




Figure 2 shows the Pilbara, Kimberley, Goldfields and Midwest regions have the highest proportions of younger HACC care recipients – these include care recipients under 65 years of age and Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander care recipients who are under 50 years of age. This data was similar to last year's report where the proportion of younger HACC care recipients recorded for the Pilbara, Kimberley, Goldfields and Midwest regions were 25.7%, 22.7%, 23.6% and 22.2%, respectively.

Similar with previous years, the number of female HACC care recipients outnumbered male HACC care recipients across all regions in Western Australia. In total, there were almost twice as many female care recipients (63.5% female versus 36.5% male). These proportions were similar to 2014/15 where there were 63.8% female care recipients and 36.1% male care recipients. Across the state 34 care recipients recorded gender as 'Not stated', a slight decrease from 35 care recipients in last year's report.

In 2015/16, more than half (**58.9%**) of all HACC care recipients were born in Australia, showing a slight decrease from 59.1% last year. The highest proportion of HACC care recipients born in a country other than Australia were from Europe (**27.5%**), followed by Asia (**5.4%**). These figures were 27.2% and 5.3% respectively, in 2014/15. Country of birth was not recorded for **3.8%** of HACC care recipients in this year's data (down from 4.0% in 2014/15).

In 2015/16, the majority of HACC care recipients recorded English as their main language spoken at home, accounting for **88.8%** of all HACC care recipients. This was a slight increase from last year's report where 88.6% of HACC care recipients recorded English as their main language spoken.

HACC care recipients, who recorded a language other than English as their main spoken language made up **7.2%** of the total number of HACC care recipients in 2015/16. The highest proportion of non English speaking care recipients reported European languages as being their main language spoken at home (**4.6%** of all HACC care recipients); these included Southern European languages (mainly Italian, Greek and French), Eastern European languages (mainly Polish, Macedonian and Croatian) and Northern European languages (mainly German and Dutch). This was similar to last year's figures where 4.7% of HACC care recipients recorded a European language as the main language spoken at home.

As in 2014/15, the Kimberley, Goldfields and Pilbara regions recorded the highest number of HACC care recipients whose main spoken language was an Australian Aboriginal language: **204**, **162** and **124** care recipients respectively out of a total **537** care recipients who recorded Australian Aboriginal language as their main language spoken at home. These were decreases of 32.7%, 1.2% and 19.5% in the Kimberley, Goldfields and Pilbara regions respectively.

Main language spoken at home was not recorded for **4.0%** of all HACC care recipients, a slight increase from last year's 3.9%. In actual numbers, it was **2,986** care recipients vs. 2,901 care recipients in 2014/15 who did not record a main language spoken at home.

In the 2015/16 reporting period, **3.2%** of all WA HACC care recipients were Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, a **0.1%** decrease from 3.3% in 2014/15. The majority of Aboriginal care recipients (**76.9%**) were aged 50 years and over. This figure was **77.3%** in last year's report.

The proportion of care recipients where Indigenous status was recorded as 'not stated' was **3.9%**, decreasing from last year's 4.4%.




Figure 3: Number of Aboriginal Care Recipients by Region

The highest number of Aboriginal care recipients amongst the rural and remote areas lived in the Kimberley, Goldfields and Midwest regions. When compared with last year's report, this was a decrease of **18.3%** (419 vs. 513 in 2014/15) in the Kimberley region, and increases of **7.9%** (341 vs. 316 in 2014/15) and **0.4%** (258 vs. 257 in 2014/15) in the Goldfields and Midwest region, in the number of Aboriginal care recipients.

Within the metropolitan area, the majority of Aboriginal care recipients were from the South East Metropolitan and East Metropolitan regions, which was consistent with data from 2014/15. The proportion of Aboriginal HACC care recipients decreased by **5.7%** in the East Metropolitan region (**182** vs. 193 in 2014/15) and by **15.2%** in the South East Metropolitan region (**330** vs. 389 in 2014/15).

The majority of HACC care recipients live in privately owned homes (64.5% vs. 63.8 % in 2014/15) or in rental accommodation (18.7% vs. 18.6%). A further 7.8% reside in an independent living unit within a retirement village (7.3% in 2014/15) and 3.8% in 'other' accommodation which includes 'boarding house/private hotel', 'short-term crisis, emergency or transitional accommodation facility', 'supported accommodation or supported living facility', 'institutional setting', 'public place/temporary shelter', 'private residence rented from an Aboriginal Community' and 'other' (3.9% in 2014/15).

The proportion of care recipients who did not record an accommodation setting (i.e. 'Not stated') was **5.2%**, a decrease from last year's 6.5%.



Figure 4: Pension or Benefit Status




Care recipients who received an aged pension made up **63.9%** of all HACC care recipients, a **0.9%** increase from 63.0% in 2014/15.

A further **14.6%** (14.9% in 2014/15) were receiving a disability pension and **3.9%** (4.3% in 2014/15) were on a veteran's pension. Of the remaining, **9.0%** of clients received no government pension or benefit (same as last year) and a combined **3.8%** were receiving other government benefit/pension, unemployment related benefits or a carer pension (3.3% in 2014/15).

The proportion of HACC care recipients who did not record a pension or benefit status (i.e. 'Not stated') decreased to **4.8%** from 5.5% in last year's report.

People were referred to the WA HACC Program from a range of sources; these included community-based services (35.0%), self-referrals (17.2%), hospitals (11.7%), family, significant other or friends (9.4%), general or medical practitioner (6.4%), as well as others shown in Figure 5 above.

These proportions were similar to the 2014/15 HACC MDS annual report, with a **0.7%** increase in the proportion of referrals from community based services (34.3% in 2014/15) and a **0.1%** increase in the proportion of self referrals (17.1% in 2014/15).

The proportion of HACC care recipients who had a carer recorded in 2015/16 was **25.3%**, a slight decrease from 25.7% in last year's report. HACC care recipients who did not record having a carer comprised **71.3%** (up from 70.7% in 2014/15).

The 'Not stated' cases regarding carer availability decreased by **0.2%** (**3.4%** vs. 3.6% in last year's report).

Consistent with data from the 2014/15 report, the majority of HACC carers belong to the age groups 75-89 years (32.1%) and 50-64 years (27.2%).

The percentage of carers older than 90 years of age showed an increase of **0.3%** (**3.2%** up from 2.9% in 2014/15) while the proportion of carers in the 0-20 age group remained the same as last year (**1.5%**). Carers with age 'Not stated' decreased by **0.1%** compared to last year's report (**0.7%** down from 0.8% in 2014/15).




Figure 6: Proportions of Carers by Age Group & Region

The proportion of carers receiving HACC assistance was the highest amongst the 0-20 age group (21.9%), followed by the 21-49 age group with 18.4%. This was followed by the 65-74 age group with 16.9% receiving HACC assistance. When compared to the 2014/15 HACC MDS annual report, the proportion of carers receiving HACC assistance was the highest amongst the 0-20 age group (20.8%), followed by the 21-49 age group with 19.5% and both the 50-64 and 65-74 age groups with 16.8% receiving HACC assistance.

Again this year, there are more female than male carers (12,367 females vs. 6,278 males). These figures were 12,678 females and 6,416 males in 2014/15.

Proportionally more female carers were receiving carer specific services (**16.9%** females and **10.8%** males). These figures were 17.5% and 11.2% respectively in the 2014/15 HACC MDS annual report.



In this year's reporting period, 50,598 care recipients had assessment volumes recorded across WA, a 3.0% increase from 2014/15.

Conversely, there was a significant decrease in the number of care recipients receiving Counselling, support, information and advocacy for care recipients; **8,041** compared to 12,047 in 2014/15 (-33.3%), and client care coordination; **4,726** compared to 6,882 in 2014/15 (-31.3%).

The most frequent HACC support service in the 2015/16 reporting period was Domestic assistance (33,584 care recipients, +1.6% from 2014/15) followed by Transport (17,631 care recipients, -1.2%), Home maintenance (17,610 care recipients, -0.3%), Social support (13,545 care recipients, -1.7%), Nursing care (11,020 care recipients, +10.7%), Centre-based day care (9,456 care recipients, -5.4%), Personal Care (7,009 care recipients, -2.0%).

Other service types included Allied health (4,769 care recipients, +11.6%), Provision of goods and equipment (4,506 care recipients, +17.9%), Meals (4,418 care recipients, -9.0%), Counselling, support, information and advocacy for carers (1,836 carers, -10.0%) and Respite care (1,266 carers, -14.3%).

The service types recording the lowest number of care recipients were similar to the 2014/15 report: Home modifications and other food services had 1,085 (+11.1%) and 494 (-18.8%) care recipients respectively. Linen service recorded 1 care recipient compared to last year (no service volumes).



Comment:

The highest volume by hours of support provided to care recipients in this year was again for Centre-based day care. HACC care recipients who received Centre-based day care for one or more quarters received an average of **165.1** hours over the year, a **0.5%** increase from 164.3 hours last year. The next highest average volumes per client were **76.5** hours for Respite care (**-4.0%** from 79.7 hours in 2014/15), followed by **60.7** hours for Social support (**+3.1%** from 58.9 hours in 2014/15), **52.1** hours for Personal care (**+0.6%** from 51.8 hours in 2013/14), and **47.3** hours for Other food services (**+29.9%** from 36.4 hours in 2014/15). The order of ranking by 'highest volumes by hours of service' this year is mostly similar to the 2014/15 HACC MDS Annual Report. In actual average volume by hours there were increases for most service types except for Counselling services for Care Recipients, Allied health, Nursing care and Respite care.

Support services measured in quantities had the following average volumes: **105.7** Meals (-**1.8%** from 107.6 in 2014/15), **50.0** units for Linen service (no service volumes in 2014/15), **49.2** trips for transport (-**1.4%** from 49.9 in 2014/15), and **1.5** units for Goods and equipment (-**31.8%** from 2.2 in 2014/15). The ranking was mostly similar to the 2014/15 HACC MDS Annual Report.

For Home modifications which are recorded as actual costs, the average cost per care recipient who received this assistance type was **\$2,255.40**. This was **8.4%** lower than the average cost in 2014/15 (\$2,460.90).

Comment:

The majority of clients (46.2%) received only one type of assistance, followed by 24.8% receiving two types, 14.3% with three types and 7.9% with four. This is similar to last year's proportions of 44.8%, 24.4%, 14.3% and 8.2% respectively.

Of the remaining, **6.8%** had between five and nine service types with **27** clients receiving ten or more types of assistance. These figures were 8.1% and 43 respectively in the 2014/15 HACC Annual Report.

Figure 9: Number of Different Service Types Received by Clients






Figure 10: Reason for Cessation of HACC Support

In this year's reporting period, a total of **16,844** care recipients ceased receiving services from the HACC program for various reasons; this was a **4.5**% decrease compared to last year's report (or 794 care recipients less). The majority (**27.6**%) reported the reason for cessation was improved status where assistance was no longer required. This figure is higher than last year's report (23.8%). A further **16.1**% recorded not requiring assistance from a particular service provider due to improved status (14.2% in 2014/15) but may have continued with a different type of assistance from another service provider.

Other reasons reported by HACC service providers for cessation of assistance included: reasons not specified (9.2%), care recipient died (8.7%), client moved to other community based service (8.4%), care recipient terminated service (8.3%), care recipient moved to residential aged care (7.4%), care recipient moved out of area (3.8%), care recipient moved to other institutional setting (2.4%) and agency was unable to provide assistance (1.5%). The remaining 6.5% of care recipients who ceased receiving services in 2015/16 did not record a reason for cessation of HACC services, a decrease from 7.6% in 2014/15.

Comment:

The 2015/16 reporting period recorded no changes in the proportion of missing data for most variables presented on Table 21. Compared to last year's report, the variable *Postcode*, *Gender*, and care recipient's *Main Language* remained the same at **0.00%**, **0.05%** and **3.9%** respectively.

Missing data for the variable *Country of Birth* decreased to **3.8%** compared to last year's report (4.0% in 2014/15). Missing data for *Indigenous status* decreased by **0.5%** (**3.9%** vs. 4.4% in 2014/15)

The variable *Carer's Date of Birth* had a slightly higher proportion of missing values when compared to the 2014/15 annual report, increasing by **0.1%**. *Carer's Gender* was not recorded for **0.4%** of all carers. This figure was higher at 0.7% in last year's report.
