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## Overview

### Introduction

This report pertains to data records of Home and Community Care (HACC) clients (care recipients and their carers), who received or were receiving one or more HACC services between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014. This report includes any revised data submitted for all four quarters of the financial year 2013/14.

### The HACC Program

The HACC Program is a key provider of basic community care services to frail older people and younger people with disabilities and their carers. The HACC Program aims to maintain or improve the independence of people in these groups and to avoid or delay their premature admission to long term residential care through the provision of basic maintenance and support services.

### HACC Minimum Dataset (V2)

The data elements included in the HACC Minimum Data Set (MDS) and defined in the HACC National MDS User Guide Data Dictionary 2.0 are considered to be the minimum information requirements for reporting within the HACC program.

They relate to:

- The characteristics of care recipients (e.g. sex, date of birth, Indigenous status, functional status items)
- The circumstances of care recipients (e.g. where they live, whether they have a carer)
- The characteristics of carers (e.g. date of birth, sex, Indigenous status)
- Information about the service episode (e.g. source of referral, date of entry, date of last update)
- The assistance received by care recipients and carers from the HACC program (e.g. amounts and types of assistance received).



## Classification of Regions

HACC Planning Regions and Subregions are classified according to the Statistical Local Areas (SLAs), based on the Australian Standard Geographical Classification by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. For the purposes of this report, client data is organised into SLAs and Subregions according to care recipient residential postcode as recorded in the HACC MDS. The region classified as 'Others' includes postcodes which are missing, do not fall within any of the HACC planning regions, or relate to P.O. box addresses.



## Data Preparation

The HACC MDS is reported to the National Data Repository on a quarterly basis by HACC service providers. All clients receiving HACC services or who ceased receiving services in the quarter will have at least one MDS record. A client may have several MDS records in the period as they may be receiving HACC services from several service providers.

There were 286,866 HACC MDS records in the 2013/14 HACC revised annual data set. Of those, 1,004 records did not have any assistance recorded and were excluded leaving 285,862 records.

A total of 285,862 records were aggregated to care recipient level on the basis of the variable *SLK* resulting in **71,666** records used for the annual report.

It was observed before aggregation that many records of care recipients with multiple MDS entries had differing values for the same variable when two or more service providers were involved. It was decided, for the **purpose of comparisons with the 2012/13 HACC Annual Report**, to apply the **same aggregation rules as in the 2012/13 analysis** to determine the value of each variable used in the analysis:

- 1) The data were first **sorted by ascending SLK and Agency ID**.
- 2) Variables which by definition should have the same value if multiple records are present (i.e. *Country of Birth*, *Main Language spoken*, *Indigenous status*, *DVA*, *Pension status*)

***The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” the 2<sup>nd</sup> most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” as well as another value then the other value was used.***
- 3) Variables which could have different values in multiple records (e.g. *Postcode*, *Living arrangements*, *Accommodation setting* could be different if a care recipient moved; Carer details could be different if a carer stopped caring for a person during the year or if another carer took over; *Referral source*, *Reason for cessation* could be different in separate records)

***The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” as well as another value then the other value was used.***
- 4) Carer exists

***If this variable had a value of ‘Yes’ in one MDS record of a care recipient with multiple records in the year, then it was assumed that that care recipient had a carer regardless of other records indicating the opposite.***

5) Functional status variables

*The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” as well as another value then the other value was used.*

6) Types of assistance variables

*The values of each variable for various types of assistance were summed up to generate a variable composed of the total amount of each type of service received.*

Clients were allocated to HACC Planning regions and subregions on the basis of their residential postcode which along with suburb/town is reported in the MDS (in the variable *Locality*).

In determining **Carers** and **Carers receiving HACC services** the following variables were used:

<b>Carer:</b>	<i>Carer Exists = Yes</i>
<b>Carer receiving HACC service:</b>	a value > 0 in variable CS/A_C (Counselling-Carer) and/or a value > 0 in variable RC (Respite Care)

### Comment:

The HACC Minimum Data Set (MDS) is reported by HACC service providers, and records services provided to both care recipients and their carers. Care recipients may or may not have a carer and only a proportion of carers receive carer specific HACC services, namely - Respite Care and/or Counselling, Support, Information and Advocacy, to support them in their caring role.

The number of care recipients receiving HACC support increased by **1.5%** in the 2013/14 reporting period (**71,666** vs. 70,580 in 2012/13). The proportion of HACC care recipients who reported having a carer this year was similar to last year's (**27.6%** vs. 27.4% in 2012/13). In actual numbers, it was an increase of **2.5%** (**19,811** carers up from 19,335 last year). However, the proportion of carers receiving carer specific HACC services decreased by **1.5%** (**17.6%** down from 19.1% in last year's report). In actual numbers there were **3,479** carers receiving HACC services, as compared to 3,701 carers in 2012/13.

**Comment:**

The number of new clients refers to clients who were not receiving any HACC services in the single previous reporting quarter. This may be within the current financial year or for clients reported in the July to September quarter, in the last quarter of the previous financial year. The 2013/14 reporting period recorded a slight increase (+0.2%) in the number of new clients as compared 2012/13 (26,621 vs. 26,580 in 2012/13).



#### Comment:

During the 2013/14 reporting period, the highest proportion of HACC care recipients were from the 75-89 age group (**52.0%**), followed by those in the 65-74 age group (**18.6%**). These proportions were similar to last year's HACC report where the highest proportion of HACC care recipients was from the 75-89 age group (52.0%), followed by 18.4% in the 65-74 group. The proportion of HACC care recipients younger than 50 years was slightly lower compared to last year's report (**9.0%** vs. 9.2% in 2012/13). Conversely, the proportion of HACC care recipients aged 90 years and above was slightly higher compared to last year (**8.9%** vs. 8.7% in 2012/13).

#### Comment:

As shown in Figure 1, the Pilbara and the Kimberley regions have higher proportions of younger care recipients (ages 0-49). This was similar to data reported in 2012/13.

As with last year's report, the proportion of care recipients with a missing date of birth was very low at **0.01%**.



**Comment:**

As with last year, the female HACC care recipients outnumbered male HACC care recipients across all regions in Western Australia. In total, there were almost twice as many female care recipients (**64.9%** female versus **35.1%** male). These proportions were similar to 2012/13 where there were 65.7% female care recipients and 34.3% male care recipients. Across the state **32** care recipients did not have their sex recorded. This figure was 44 in last year's report.

**Comment:**

In 2013/14, more than half (**59.4%**) of all HACC care recipients were born in Australia, showing a slight increase from 59.1% last year. The highest proportion of HACC care recipients born in a country other than Australia were from Europe (**27.6%**), followed by Asia (**5.2%**). These figures were 27.8% and 5.4% respectively, in 2012/13. Country of birth was not recorded for **3.4%** of HACC care recipients in this year's data (3.6% in 2012/13).

**Comment:**

In 2013/14, the majority of HACC care recipients recorded English as their main language spoken at home, accounting for **88.8%** of all HACC care recipients. This was similar to last year's report where 88.5% of HACC care recipients recorded English as their main language spoken.

HACC care recipients, who recorded a language other than English as their main spoken language made up **7.9%** of the total number of HACC care recipients in 2013/14. The highest proportion of non English speaking care recipients reported European languages as being their main language spoken at home (**5.1%** of all HACC care recipients); these included Southern European languages (mainly Italian, Greek and French), Eastern European languages (mainly Polish, Macedonian and Croatian) and Northern European languages (mainly German and Dutch). This was similar to last year's figures where 5.4% of HACC care recipients recorded a European language as the main language spoken at home.

Similar to 2012/13, the Kimberley, Pilbara and Goldfields regions recorded the highest number of HACC care recipients whose main spoken language was an Australian Aboriginal language: **362**, **199** and **140** care recipients respectively out of a total **751** care recipients who recorded Australian Aboriginal language as their main language spoken at home. These were increases of 30.2%, 32.6% and 14.8% in the Kimberley, Pilbara and Goldfields regions respectively.

Main language spoken at home was not recorded for **3.2%** of all HACC care recipients, similar to last year's 3.3%. In actual numbers, it was **2,313** care recipients vs. 2,330 care recipients in 2012/13 who did not record a main language spoken at home.



**Comment:**

In the 2013/14 reporting period, **3.5%** of all WA HACC care recipients were Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islanders, a **0.2%** increase from last year. The majority of Aboriginal care recipients (**76.2%**) were aged 50 years and over. This figure was 73.8% in the 2012/13 report.

The proportion of care recipients where Indigenous status was recorded as 'not stated' was **3.8%**, decreasing from last year's 4.1%.

#### Comment:

The highest number of Aboriginal care recipients amongst the rural and remote areas lived in the Kimberley, Goldfields and Pilbara regions. When compared with last year's report, there were increases of **22.6%** (608 vs. 496 in 2012/13), **14.4%** (301 vs. 263 in 2012/13) and **25.1%** (269 vs. 215 in 2012/13) across the Kimberley, Goldfields and Pilbara regions, respectively in the number of Aboriginal care recipients.

Within the metropolitan area, the majority of Aboriginal care recipients were from the South East Metropolitan and East Metropolitan regions, which was consistent with data from 2012/13. The proportion of Aboriginal HACC care recipients decreased by **13.5%** in the East Metropolitan region (**192** vs. 222 in 2012/13) and by **1.6%** in the South East Metropolitan region (**381** vs. 387 in 2012/13).

**Comment:**

Care recipients who either live alone or with family were almost of equal proportions (**44.4%** and **49.0%** respectively); this was similar to last year's report where 45.4% of care recipients lived alone and 47.6% of care recipients lived with family. The proportion of care recipients who did not record a living arrangement (i.e. 'Not stated') decreased by **0.3%** (**3.7%** vs. 4.0% in 2012/13).

#### Comment:

Similar to last year's report, the majority of HACC care recipients live in privately owned homes (64.6% vs. 65.2% in 2012/13) or in rental accommodation (19.3% vs. 19.7%). A further 7.0% reside in an independent living unit within a retirement village (6.4% in 2012/13) and 4.1% in 'other' accommodation which includes 'boarding house/private hotel', 'short-term crisis, emergency or transitional accommodation facility', 'supported accommodation or supported living facility', 'institutional setting', 'public place/temporary shelter', 'private residence rented from an Aboriginal Community' and 'other' (3.9% in 2012/13).

The proportion of care recipients who did not record an accommodation setting (i.e. 'Not stated') was 5.0%, a slight increase from last year's 4.8%.



**Figure 4: Care Recipient Pension or Benefit Status**




**Comment:**

Care recipients who received an aged pension made up **63.3%** of all HACC care recipients, a **0.3%** increase from 63.0% in 2012/13.

Those people receiving a disability pension comprised **15.3%** (15.3% in 2012/13) of HACC care recipients with a further **4.9%** (5.5% in 2012/13) receiving a veteran's pension. Less than 10% of care recipients received no government pension or benefit (**8.7%** vs. 8.3% last year).

The proportion of HACC care recipients who did not record their pension or benefit status (i.e. 'Not stated') decreased to **4.5%** from 4.7% in last year's report.

**Comment:**

People were referred to the WA HACC Program from a range of sources; the majority of which includes community-based services (29.1%), self-referral (19.5%), family, significant other or friends (11.8%), hospitals (11.6%), general or medical practitioner (7.3%), as well as others shown in Figure 5 above.

These proportions were similar to the 2012/13 HACC MDS annual report, with a **5.0%** increase in the proportion of referrals from community based services (24.1% in 2012/13) and a **2.3%** decrease in the proportion of self referrals (21.8% in 2012/13).

**Comment:**



#### Comment:

The majority of HACC carers belong to the age groups 75-89 years (30.1%) and 50-64 years (29.2%).

The percentage of carers older than 90 years of age decreased slightly compared to last year's report (2.9% vs. 3.1% in 2012/13), while the proportion of carers in the 0-20 age group showed an increase of 0.2% (1.3% up from 1.1% in 2012/13).

#### Comment:

The proportion of carers receiving HACC assistance was the highest amongst the 21-49 age group (**20.7%**), followed by the 50-64 age group with **19.2%** and the 0-20 age group with **18.0%** receiving HACC assistance. These patterns in proportions were similar to the 2012/13 HACC MDS annual report but the proportions of carers receiving HACC assistance were slightly lower (in 2012/13 highest amongst the 21-49 age group was 22.2%, followed by the 50-64 age group with 20.9% and the 65-74 age group with 19.8% of carers receiving HACC assistance).



**Comment:**

In this year's reporting period, **44,445** care recipients had assessment volumes recorded across WA, a **9.0%** increase from 2012/13.

Conversely, there was a decrease in the number of care recipients receiving client care coordination; **9,757** compared to 10,186 in 2012/13 (**-4.2%**).

The most frequent HACC support service in the 2012/13 reporting period was Domestic assistance (**31,991** care recipients, **+3.9%** from 2011/12) followed by Transport (**18,273** care recipients, **+0.1%**), Home maintenance (**17,633** care recipients, **+6.2%**), Social support (**14,157** care recipients, **-1.2%**), Counselling, support, information and advocacy for care recipient (**12,327** care recipients, **+2.6%**), Centre-based day care (**10,881** care recipients, **-2.1%**), Nursing care (**9,773** care recipients, **+9.7%**), and Personal Care (**6,709** care recipients, **+1.5%**).

Other service types included Meals (**5,756** care recipients, **-12.3%**), Provision of goods and equipment (**3,899** care recipients, **-0.2%**), Allied health (**3,714** care recipients, **-14.5%**), Counselling, support, information and advocacy for carer (**2,188** carers, **-8.5%**) and Respite care (**1,577** carers, **-10.5%**).

The service types recording the lowest number of care recipients were similar to the 2012/13 report: Linen service, Other food services and Home modification with **11** (**-42.1%**), **722** (**-12.4%**) and **746** (**+32.3%**) care recipients respectively.



### Comment:

The highest volume by hours of support provided to care recipients in this financial year was again for Centre-based day care. HACC care recipients who received Centre-based day care for one or more quarters received an average of **161.6** hours over the year, a **1.0%** increase from 160.6 hours last year. The next highest average volumes per client were **79.3** hours for Respite care (+3.1% from 76.9 hours in 2012/13), followed by **49.7** hours for Personal care (-6.0% from 52.9 hours in 2012/13), **49.1** hours for Social support (+8.9% from 45.1 hours in 2012/13) and **29.8** hours for Domestic assistance (-5.4% from 31.5 hours in 2012/13). The order of ranking by 'highest volumes by hours of service' this year is mostly similar to the 2012/13 HACC MDS Annual Report. In actual average volume by hours there were decreases for most service types except for Centre-based day care, Respite care, Social Support, Other food services, Home maintenance and Carers' Counselling.

For those support services measured in quantities, the highest average volumes provided were, **103.0** Meals (**-2.6%** from 105.8 in 2012/13), **49.1** trips for transport (**-0.6%** from 49.4 in 2012/13), and **4.0** units for Linen services (**-66.4%** from 11.9 in 2012/13). The ranking was again consistent with the 2012/13 HACC MDS Annual Report, however this shows a significant decrease in the service volume for Linen services.

For Home modification, which is recorded in cost, the average cost per care recipient who received this assistance type was **\$1,258.90**. This was 14.4% lower than the average cost in 2012/13 (\$1,470.40).



#### **Comment:**

The majority of clients (**41.6%**) received only one type of assistance, followed by **24.8%** receiving two types, **14.9%** with three types and **8.9%** with four. This is similar to last year's proportions of 41.9%, 24.3%, 14.8% and 8.7% respectively.

Of the remaining, **9.8%** had between five and nine service types with **71** clients receiving ten or more types of assistance. These figures were 10.1% and 69 respectively in the 2012/13 HACC Annual Report.


**Comment:**

**Comment:**

In this year's reporting period, a total of **18,913** care recipients ceased receiving services from the HACC program for various reasons; this was a **4.2%** increase compared to last year's report (or 766 care recipients more). The majority (**19.0%**) reported the reason for cessation was improved status where assistance was no longer required. This figure is slightly higher than last year's report (18.9%). A further **12.9%** recorded not requiring assistance from a particular service provider due to improved status (9.8% in 2012/13) but may have continued with a different type of assistance from another service provider.

Other reasons reported by HACC service providers for cessation of assistance included: client moved to other community based service (**14.2%**), reasons not specified (**12.9%**), care recipient died (**8.5%**), care recipient terminated service (**8.1%**), care recipient moved to residential aged care (**7.6%**), care recipient moved out of area (**4.1%**), service provider was unable to provide assistance (**3.1%**) and care recipient moved to other institutional setting (**2.1%**). The remaining **7.4%** of care recipients who ceased receiving services in 2013/14 did not record a reason for cessation of HACC services, a decrease from 8.5% in 2012/13.

### Comment:

The 2013/14 reporting period recorded decreases in the proportion of missing data for all variables presented in Table 21 above. The variable *Postcode* decreased to **0.00%** from 0.01% in last year's report, while *Country of Birth* decreased by **0.2%** (**3.4%** down from 3.6% in 2012/13).

Missing data for the variable *Sex* decreased to **0.04%** compared to 0.06% in last year's report. Missing data for care recipient's *Main Language* decreased by **0.1%** (**3.2%** vs. 3.3% in 2012/13).

Variables *Indigenous status* and *Carer's Sex* also had lower proportions of missing values when compared to 2012/13, decreasing by **0.3%** and **0.1%** respectively. *Carer's Date of Birth* was not recorded for **0.3%** of all carers. This figure was the same as last year's report.
