

# Western Australia Tuberculosis Control Program - 2018


The WA TB Control Program (WATBCP) located at the Anita Clayton Centre offers a specialised public health service that provides a state-wide outpatient service for the treatment, surveillance and prevention of tuberculosis. The WATBCP provides Specialist Medical advice to all cases of Active TB and Latent TB infection. There is a dedicated paediatric clinic to ensure the needs of children and their families are met. Individual case management for all clients is a nurse led approach that is an integral part of the success of the WATBCP.

#### Tuberculosis cases in WA 2018




## Number of people treated for latent **TB** cases:


### Tuberculosis notifications numbers and rates, WA, 2009-2018



### Tuberculosis notifications by Health Service Area 2018




Tuberculosis cases by place of birth, WA, 2009-2018
